Bottles of water

Juice boxes

Fresh fruit and veggies, cut up, in containers, in the cooler.

Apples and oranges. We keep these whole and in the cooler.

Cheese sticks (in the cooler)

Nuts or trail mix

Dried fruit or fruit roll ups

Granola or protein bars

Crackers

Pretzels

Candy and treats. Stay clear of messy foods that melt, like chocolate.

Small bags or containers to distribute food to everyone

#### FOILETRIES

Prescription medicines, more than enough for the trip to take delays into account

Tylenol or other headache medication

Sunscreen

Toiletries like shampoo, conditioner, and personal care products.

Kleenex tissues

Hand sanitizer

Hand lotion

Bug spray

Chapstick

Roll of toilet paper. This is essential for when those road pit stop washrooms are out of TP.

#### SAFETY

Car safety kit (Booster cables, flares, markers, etc.)

Spare tire. Ensure it is inflated and in good condition.

AMA or other roadside assistance card
